Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

There are numerous signs in our society that something is breaking down. Studies reveal that the percentage of Americans suffering from depression and personality disorders continues to rise. Anxiety, stress, and health issues are causing Americans to turn to medication to cope with their problems. Chronic loneliness is endemic, and social media seems to exacerbate the problem rather than alleviate it. Violence,

such as school shootings, are becoming commonplace.

All of these concerns are not the root cause of our illness, but merely the symptoms. The underlying cause is twofold: alienation from God, and alienation from each other.

When asked which of the divinely-inspired commandments is greatest,

Jesus Christ responded, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets" (Matt 22:37-40). In summarizing the Law in this way, our Lord reveals to us the solution to our present dilemma.

We learn to love God, and our fellow human beings, through the life of the Church. In the context of fellowship and service within our local parish, we are given an opportunity to break free from complacency. St John the Evangelist and Apostle writes, "If someone says, 'I love God,' and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, how can he love God whom he has not seen?" (1 Jn 4:20) In the parish, we learn to love God *through* love for others. While anyone can give lip-service to their faith in God and love for mankind, only those who put it into practice become true Christians.

When we learn to love our fellow parishioners, something amazing happens: we become a spiritual family. We begin

to share in one another's lives,

to support one another's spiritual growth, and to assist one another in times of need. Such ties become stronger the more we seek out each other's presence. And the relationships we forge prevent the sort of isolation and disintegration that leads to loneliness, depression, angst, and episodes of violence.

With the love we share in the Church, worked out and lived in our local parish, we also learn to love those outside our faith community: our neighbors and coworkers. Our spiritual integrity enables us to stand against the tide of fragmentation so prevalent in our world. In this way, the light of Christ can shine in the darkness.

Commemorations during the Liturgy

It is our practice in the Orthodox Church that parishioners can ask the priest pray for their family and acquaintances during the Divine Liturgy. Lists of names are sent up to the Sanctuary for this purpose. In some traditions, a small loaf of bread (prosphora) accompanies the list of names. However, many parishioners are confused about the practice, and also many do not retrieve their loaf after the Liturgy. Please observe these guidelines:

- 1) You can fill out the commemoration sheet anytime prior to the Great Entrance (when the Chalice processes around).
 - 2) Only list first names (no nick-names); and please list non-Orthodox names on the bottom half.
 - 3) You can fill out a commemoration sheet without purchasing a prosphora loaf. The loaves will remain behind the counter, available upon request. If you purchase a loaf, do not forget to take it after the Liturgy.
