Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Autumn marks a time of transition, both in the Chuch, and in the world. It is the beginning of a new ecclesiastical year, when the fixed cycle of feastdays and the commemoration of Saints begins. It is also the time of year when our Church School starts up again, as well as our Adult Education classes. This coincidence reminds me of the role that the Church calendar and the lives of the Saints plays in our spiritual education.

Every day is an opportunity to learn more about our faith, and to model our lives after those men and women who were imitators of Christ.

For the world at large, Autumn is the time when the youth return to public and private schools and universities. As we consider these two types of education—religious and secular—we may

notice a difference between them. No longer do such schools teach us anything about right and wrong, good and evil. Secular education has become a means to fill our minds with information, while leaving our souls empty. For this reason, it is more important than ever that we turn to the Church to learn our moral and spiritual precepts.

In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus Christ instructs us to, "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you" (28:19). Pivotal to His proclamation are the words "teach" and "disciple." The English word

"disciple" is linked to the word "discipline," and tells us something about how the early Christians understood education. It was not considered simply the transfer of information, but rather the molding or formation of the student. The goal, as Christ tells us, is to learn to obey everything He has commanded. In other words, the Church teaches us how to live.

In the secular world, education reaches its conclusion at the end each program, culminating

in a graduation ceremony. But our

spiritual education continues on for the rest of our lives. We remain students of Christ until our last breath.

As we pray for the return of students to school, let us all be reminded that we are in still in class, to speak. The final test will be in front of the "dread judgment seat of Christ." Will we pass or fail? Will we receive honors—

an imperishable crown—or eternal detention? As disciples of Christ, we will be accountable for what we learn and how we apply it. May we be found worthy to ever rejoice at that glorious graduation banquet in the Kingdom of Heaven.
