Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

Theophany is one of the Great Twelve Feasts of the Orthodox Church, as well as the patronal feast of our Cathedral. Just as the secular calendar begins a new year, so the Church celebrates the newness of life in Christ signified by the sanctification of water. Throughout the ancient world, water was perceived as a sign of both life and death. Water is necessary to

sustain living creatures, but it can also be a destructive force, such as hurricanes, floods, and tsunamis.

This dual symbolism was not lost on the Apostles. They understood that when Jesus went down into the Jordan, he "crushed the heads of the invisible dragons," as the priest says in the prayers of blessing water. Our Lord overcame death in Himself, and

brought new life to the world—beginning with His blessing of the river He was immersed into.

For each of us who has been baptized into Christ, water has become a passageway from death to life. We first are buried with Christ so that we can then be raised with Him (Rom 6:4). The blessing of Holy Water is an integral part of this act. The Church, through its priests, reclaims God's creation so that it may once more be called "good." Once the water is sanctified, it becomes the means by which the believer receives grace, redemption, and the gift of the Holy Spirit.

The Feast of Theophany, therefore, is not

simply the commemoration of an historical event, it is an annual reminder of what has happened to us in baptism. The Lord has come to offers us new life, and this new life begins when we go down into the Jordan to be transformed.

The past year has been trying for all of us. Fear and anger, sadness and loneliness have attacked us. Our souls long for peace. But the peace we long for will never be found on this side of

Paradise. Christ can offer us a taste

of peace when we pursue His righteousness and holiness; but it is only a glimmer of the eternal peace that surpasses all understanding.

As we start a new civil year, let us look to Christ and focus on "the one thing needful" (Luke 10:42). There are grave temptations on all sides. We are constantly being seduced by politics and ideology, pleasures and

comforts, pride and selfishness. But when we pursue Christ and His Kingdom, we leave behind the "old man" (Rom 6:6) and put on the new life of the Holy Spirit.

May each of you experience a blessed New Year, and may our Lord offer you a taste of that eternal peace which is to come.
