Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

For Orthodox Christians living in the United States, the Fourth of July is an important reminder of that fundamental freedom that enables our Church to flourish: the liberty to believe and worship as we see fit. Many of our ancestors made the arduous journey to the New World because of religious oppression they were facing in the Polish Empire, the Austro-Hungarian Empire, the Ottoman Empire, or later under

the Soviet Bloc. In America, they could raise their children in the faith without fear.

It is good to remember where we came from—and to continue to defend religious freedom in our own time—but there is another, more important freedom that our Lord Jesus Christ calls us to: freedom from sin.

One of the ironies of modern life is that we are offered

so many choices, and yet we are enslaved to the things we choose. We mistakenly believe that choice makes us free; but in fact, we are often compelled to choose in order to satisfy our unruly desires. We are drowning in the marketplace of goods, services, and ideologies. Homo Sapiens has now become Homo Consumerus.

If ever I want to test myself, to see if this is the case, all I need do is expose myself to some temptation and then see how quickly I succumb. Whatever our strongest passions are, there are a myriad of ways to satisfy them. And the moment we are presented with the various choices, we begin to struggle with ourselves.

But there is only one choice that proves we are truly free: abstention. When we choose *not* to choose, it means that the things we desire do not control us. It means that we are able to make rational choices, not based on our passions or emotional states, but according to God's will.

One of the reasons we are unable to make free choices is because we think we must act alone. When faced with temptations, we may struggle for a time, and then fall into sin because we lack

the strength to continue the

battle. Or perhaps we give in immediately because we do not believe we have the fight in us at all.

In both instances, we are relying on our own strength. In truth, none of us is strong enough to overcome sin on our own. We need God to empower us by his grace in order to obtain victory in our spiritual struggles. And we

only receive that grace when we

surrender ourselves into God's hands. By regular and sincere prayer, and with the constant admission of our weakness, he will come to our defense.

We are not truly free until we are free from sin. Until then, our choices become tyranny as we constantly battle against tempation. May the Lord grant his aid so that we may ultimately participate in his victory over sin.
