Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

The month of October is a time of transition each year. It's the liminal time between summer and winter, when the days are growing shorter and nature begins to rest. And liturgically, it's a relatively calm month before the Nativity cycle begins in November, giving us time to reflect on life and focus on our most basic Christian works.

As was the case in American history, this period of autumn was a harvest season for the ancient Israelites. And with the harvest came the offering of "first-fruits": a tithe of the farmer's crop to God by giving it to his Temple. In connection with this, it's also the time our parish conducts its annual Pledge Drive so that we can likewise offer our first-fruits to God. Our duty today remains the same as that of God's people millennia ago.

As we consider what it means to give to God, it is important to remember what he was given to us: *everything*. St Paul asks, "What do you have that you did not receive?" (1 Cor 4:7). The money we earn, the clothes we wear, the bounty we eat, the roof over our heads, even the air we breathe—all these things are a gift from the Lord. Our very lives are sustained each day by him.

And yet, we often forget this, and act as though we possess the gifts we've received. We often go through life blind of the many blessings we have; and as a result we constantly clamor for more. Contentment is a virtue generally lacking in our

society.

Fr. Alexander Schmemann oft referred to secularism as the most prevalent modern heresy. It is not that people aren't "religious," he would say, but that their religion is somehow cut-off from the rest of their lives: tamed and allocated to one day a week (unless there is something better to do on a Sunday). This modern outlook stands in stark contradiction to the total fidelity we are called to in the Scriptures.

Drawing on Deut 6:4-5, Jesus Christ tells us that we must

love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Mk 12:29-30). He doesn't want part of us, or part of our time and commitment, he wants all of us.

So what does this look like in practical terms? It means putting God first in all we do. We put him first in terms of time when we schedule

our day around prayer and our

week around liturgical services; and when we make time to pray, fast, and be charitable to others. And we put him first in terms of finances when we budget out our tithe before indulging ourselves.

To be called by the name "Christian" is an honor because it means we bear our Lord's name. But it's also a grave responsibility to dedicate ourselves to him in all things, always putting him first.
