Dear Brothers & Sisters in Christ,

September is a month of transition. Summer gives way to autumn. Schedules change as students return to school. And in Miami, hurricane season reaches its peak. But what we often overlook is that September is also the beginning of a new ecclesiastical year. Not January 1, but September 1 is New Year's Day for the Church.

Instead of making empty resolutions about self-fulfillment (as many

do in January), let's make spiritual resolutions for the ecclesiastical year ahead. It's a perfect time to rededicate ourselves to serving God, and to building up his holy Church.

There are many possibilities for resolutions. We can commit to attending the Divine Liturgy weekly. Or if we already do this, we

can commit to at least one extra

weekday service per month. We can commit to attending an educational offering: the monthly Orthodoxy 201, the weekly Bible Study, or the Adult Catechism that will be offered on Thursday evenings this autumn.

Another way we can rededicate ourselves is financially. September is the month of the Cathedral's annual Pledge Drive. Often, Christians do not want to talk about their giving because they do not want to accept that generosity is a reflection of spirituality. This month is an opportunity to reflect on our donations, and to make strides toward the ideal given in Scripture (tithing). When we consider the "talents" that God has gifted us and asked us to spiritually invest, our time is as important as our treasures. This month could be an opportunity to volunteer more at the parish. We always need more people to make and bring food to Agape Hour, and to help clean up at the end. Some of us come, eat, and leave, benefitting from the labor and love of others but not contributing themselves. Let's make a resolution to get more involved in our Agape Hour.



The Parish Work Day is yet another chance to pitch in. One Saturday per month is a small commitment, but an important one. Yet fewer and fewer are volunteering for this. As the old saying goes, "Many hands make light work."

And last, but not least, each of us should make some personal resolutions. Perhaps you have not been doing evening prayers, and can initiate (or restart) this practice.

Perhaps you haven't been reading the Scriptures or writings of the saints, and can set aside time each week for this. Or perhaps you've been lenient with fasting, and can commit to eating vegan on Wednesdays and Fridays. These are all ways to deepen your commitment to Christ.

New Year's Day only comes once a year, so let's resolve to be better Christians in the year to come!
